Maryland law requires that:

- All persons flagging along Maryland roads have passed the Maryland approved flagger course.
- All flagging operations be performed by individuals who have successfully completed the American Traffic Safety Services Association (ATSSA) Flagger Training Course. Each flagger must be in possession of an approved flagger training card at all times. Flagging is to be conducted utilizing stop/slow paddles in complete accordance with Part VI Section 6E of the current edition of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

This is the ATSSA Flagger Training Course that is REQUIRED for construction work zone flaggers in both one- and two-person flagging operations. Experienced flaggers can attend as refresher training.
